FMD: 13 June 2022*

Foot-and-mouth disease (FMD) is a severe, highly contagious viral disease of livestock that has a significant economic impact. The disease affects cattle, swine, sheep, goats and other cloven-hoofed ruminants. FMD is caused by an Aphthovirus of the family Picornaviridae, seven strains (A, O, C, SAT1, SAT2, SAT3, and Asia1) are endemic in different countries worldwide.

A suspected case, in a male bull of local breed, of foot-and-mouth disease was reported in Jarithang village, Ugyentse gewog, Samtse dzongkhag on 10 June 2022. As per the flash report shared, all the control measures, including case investigation and ring vaccination around the delineated infected zone, were implemented in line with the National FMD Prevention and Control Plan 2020.
